This list of holidays has been compiled to assist ministers, ritual abuse survivors, intercessors, and those in spiritual warfare battles to be aware of what occult activities could be impacting them throughout the year. There are many groups listed above that practice various forms of rituals, yet not all of the groups are evil.

For ritual abuse survivors, their birthday is often considered a ritual holiday. Such is the case with Satanism, Paganism and Thelema. Many normal liturgical religious practices are used to celebrate Catholic holidays, but some individuals or groups also use these occasions for a black mass. The Jewish holidays are listed because Nazis, Freemasons and those who say they are Jews but are of the synagogue of Satan may perform rituals to purposely coincide with the timing of Biblical Feasts. Hindu holidays are noted in this list due to the celebration of these dates by many pagan groups. There are eight major dates in the calendar noted in red. These are the major occult holidays celebrated by Druids, Pagans/Witches, Freemasons, Thelema practitioners, and Satanists.
