

The Minister's Advanced SRA Training Academy

The "Academy," as we call it for short, is a specialized training program for Christian ministers called to serve severely traumatized individuals recovering from ritual abuse. The program offers 18 training modules and four practical application opportunities called practicums. The curriculum is divided into four training tracks as outlined below.

Training Modules

Students can purchase only one training module at a time. An instructor will be assigned for each module and all homework will be submitted to the instructor via email.

Each module must be successfully completed with the approval of the instructor before the next module can be purchased. Students are encouraged to complete each track that they start, but completion of all the tracks is not a requirement unless certification is desired.

TRACK 1 = Healing the Broken Heart

The Zoom meeting for this track will be held on the first Thursday of each month.

This track contains four modules plus a practical application session.

Module 1 - SRA Recovery & The Ministry Calling

Modules 2 thru 4 - Sexual Abuse, Trauma Memory, Dissociation (DID) and the Healing of the Broken Heart

TRACK 2 = Advanced Deliverance

The Zoom meeting for this track will be held on the second Thursday of each month.

This track contains six modules plus a practical application session.

Module 5 lays a foundation for occult deliverance. Modules 6 through 10 explore Catholicism, Mormonism, Freemasonry, Druidism, New Age beliefs, and many additional forms of witchcraft and advanced occultism.

TRACK 3 = Mind Control Deprogramming

The Zoom meeting for this track will be held on the First Tuesday of each month.

This track contains six modules plus a practical application session.

Modules 11 through 16 explore the history of mind control, how it is installed, and how it is being used today. The last module in this series explores artificial intelligence and transhumanism. Discover the use of Disney stories, fairy tales, movies and television programs used for mind control programming today.

TRACK 4 = Practical Application

The Zoom meeting for this track will be held on the third Tuesday of each month.

This track contains only 2 modules.

Module 17 - Right Brain Modalities - Art & Sand Tray

Module 18 - Onsite 40-hour practicum.

Books

Each module's syllabus requires the purchase of several books and various other resources. A book list will be made available for each track. Most resources are available for purchase through Amazon.com, although some of the Advanced Deliverance materials are purchased from Fruitful Vine in Australia. A good book budget estimate is about \$80 per module. The good news is that you will be building your ministry library with resources you can refer to repeatedly.

How Much Time is Required?

This is master's level college material with books to read and papers to write. If students wish to complete a module in five weeks, a good time estimate is ten hours per week, plus one or two monthly meetings of 1.5 hours. This varies per student. With this self-paced program, students will have up to ten weeks to complete a module. The time extensions for the completion of a module will require prior approval from the instructor.

Syllabus & Homework

A syllabus will be provided for each module. The syllabus outlines the objectives of the module and defines the resources and homework requirements, as well as the grading plan.

Each module contains five or more videos to watch with corresponding PowerPoint slides to print. Videos can be watched through the website or downloaded to your computer.

Academy alumni often share that they use the weekly homework as reference material for ministry sessions. It is suggested that each student organize their homework in such a way that it can be used repeatedly for years to come. Many students have a binder for each module, with tabs for each of the five sections. Most students print the PowerPoint slides and take notes from the videos.

A final paper is due at the conclusion of most modules. These papers are called Implementation Papers because they are to be focused on the implementation of all that a student learns in the module.

Monthly Meetings

Students on each track are required to attend at least one Zoom meeting each month. A second meeting is also available for those who wish more interaction and discussion, or those who wish to complete modules more quickly. Two meetings are required to complete a module.

Kay Tolman will be leading these monthly meetings. Each meeting will focus on the materials specific to the module track students are currently on. Students are encouraged to prepare questions and comments for the meeting discussion. We believe people learn best when they have a chance to discuss what they are studying. By having an opportunity to ask questions and discuss these topics, we can all learn from each other. Students will have a webpage to reference for specific meeting agenda items, meeting guidelines, and further instructions or announcements.

Grades

Each module contains a syllabus with specific details for earning points toward a module grade. Points are earned for the completion of each assignment and for attendance at the monthly Zoom meetings. A module grade report and a summary grade report will be provided for each student at the completion of each module.

Certificates

Certificates of training are available for students that have completed all the requirements for each training track. The successful completion of all four training tracks can qualify students to become certified SRA ministers through Revelation Gateway Ministries.

Instructors

Revelation Gateway's Academy instructors are experienced ministers that have successfully completed the program. Our instructors are incredibly gifted at teaching, and they love what they do. They are Holy Spirit inspired ministry leaders that are excited about walking through this journey with you.

Kay Tolman is the Academy Dean. She supervises this highly qualified team of instructors. All the Academy curriculum, including videos, were produced by Kay Tolman. She has a master's degree in Christian Counseling and nearly twenty years of SRA ministry experience. Kay has walked through more than thirty years of her own recovery from satanic ritual abuse. She brings a wealth of experience to this learning opportunity.

Application Screening Process

The Academy is a unique learning experience. Unlike most educational environments, this one is very spiritual and emotional, often triggering unhealed areas in those participating. As such, we have found that application screening is helpful to the success of our students as well as our instructors. We hope to ensure each student is in a good place to embark on this journey.

The screening process begins with an application. After careful review of your application, you will receive an email. If we feel the Academy is a good fit for you at this time, we will schedule a brief Zoom meeting to get to know each other and discuss next steps. This will also give you an opportunity to ask questions.

Once approved to join the Academy, you will receive an application approval letter.

Accreditation

The Minister's Advanced SRA Training Academy is not accredited.

Financial Investment

It is wise to count the cost before embarking on this or any other training program.

- Tuition is \$480 per module, and there are 18 modules to complete for graduation. Module prices are subject to change. International students may inquire about exchange rate discounts.
- Books and resources should be budgeted at \$80 or more per module (this varies). These materials will become part of the minister's own resource library.

- You will need a working computer and a good internet connection.
- Most students enjoy the opportunity to participate in hands-on training activities. If you are able, budget for practicum travel expenses at the conclusion of tracks 1, 2 and 3.
- After the completion of the 17th module, students will be required to attend a five-day, in-person, practicum. (International students may participate via Zoom Meeting.) This is a memorable hands-on training experience. Practicum costs will involve travel, lodging, food, and transportation, as well as the module tuition fee.
- Students that have successfully completed all four tracks, including the practicum, will qualify to participate in a graduation celebration in Texas. There is a small fee for this event which is usually scheduled at the end of the practicum. It is a semi-formal affair.

International Students

Revelation Gateway Ministries welcomes international students into the Academy. Please be aware some special challenges may be inherent. Students must be able to read and write in English. Books should be purchased many weeks in advance to ensure delivery. Special arrangements may need to be made to mail materials or provide alternative online solutions. However, we are committed to seeing SRA training reach all the nations of the world. If needed, currency conversion discounts may apply for the purchase of modules. Please let us know how we can help you achieve your goals with the Academy.

Minister's DID Consortium

Students that have completed Track 1 will be invited to join other students and alumni in a half price membership to the Minister's DID Consortium. These meetings are intended to provide a sense of community by providing a forum where ministers can stay connected and participate in open forum discussions and discoveries for this ever-changing field. It is the vision of Revelation Gateway Ministries to foster long-term relationships and develop experts in a field that is constantly changing and growing. By cross pollination, we hope to continue bringing fresh insight and tools to each other as well as the Christian DID community and SRA survivors globally.

Future Vision

It is my hope that Revelation Gateway Ministries will become a place where experts around the world can work together to bring healing, tools, and resources to the broken hearted. The vision ahead includes the development of resource centers for recovery. Alumni will be invited to participate and contribute to cutting-edge information systems, while providing training and tools for global impact.
